- Introductions and visual identifiers of each property
- Plan to create small groups of neighbors to coordinate evac. at next mtg.
- Concern share from Paul Stange (sp?) re. state owned land in neighborhood neglected and a huge fire concern
- Question: how do we keep updated re. status of a fire if PG&E turns off power and phone towers are down?
  - Hamm radios -Does anyone have one?
  - Evan Williams shared idea of using 121.5 AM MHz to use emergency aviation frequency
  - Also satellite radio has frequency for emergency info.
- Discussion re. "Golden hour" – time to get belongings and people out
- Bruce McArthur shared - masks to use – N95
- Carolyn Sell noted that if there is no power we will need gas powered pumps to use garden hose to protect homes
- Keep a back pack by front door w. all items you need to take
- Someone else suggested keeping a battery packed in emergency back pack for cell phone to use after you evacuate
- Use signs that say – "HELP" or "OK"
- Keep fire extinguisher in car and by front gate
- Designate a person outside of area to contact that you are safe & share with neighborhood group
